We offer an exceptional research and educational environment:

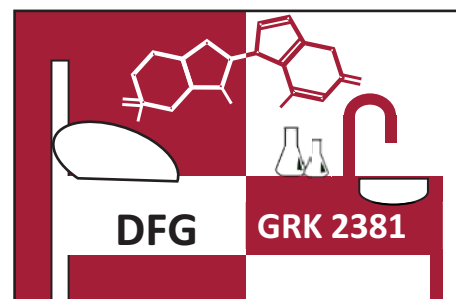
- **Multidisciplinary projects** covering biochemistry, biophysics, cell signaling, neurobiology, pharmacology, physiology
